
The Little Drummer Boy of the Rappahannock is a remarkable story that gives us hope when we're faced with death.

Robert Henry Hendershot was a 12 year old drummer boy for the 8th Michigan Infantry in the Civil War, 1862 while serving in Fredericksburg, Virginia. A boy with nerve-- was first to push off boats loaded with soldiers towards enemy territory. Accidentally, he didn't let go-- and was dragged to the enemy's battle front.

Landing on the battle front, and faced with new soldier duties-- Hendershot found a stranded enemy soldier in a basement. He gave him consolation and amazingly-- this 12 year old, brought this enemy soldier to surrender-- that saved him from death.
